**Section 1194.22 Web-based Internet information and applications – Supported Criteria**

- a. Web pages shall be designed so that all information conveyed with color is also available without color, for example from context or markup.**

The unified web digital campus has the markup which supports different type of content(s) across all portlets available in the portal. This is compatible with HTML standard markup to display different content type(s) like H1, P, SPAN etc.

- b. Documents shall be organized so they are readable without requiring an associated style sheet.**

The unified web digital campus has the Drive built-in which supports indexing of the documents which can be managed with in the drive by users and they can search the document with the name or meta data they tagged the document with while uploading.

- c. Pages shall be designed to avoid causing the screen to flicker with a frequency greater than 2 Hz and lower than 55 Hz.**

The portal does not support content flickering more than once in a second in order to avoid any issues related to ADA compliance.

- d. When pages utilize scripting languages to display content, or to create interface elements, the information provided by the script shall be identified with functional text that can be read by Assistive Technology.**

Scripts used by pages has clear indications/comments which explains why the script has been written and there are no issues while rendering those script in the browsers.

- e. When a timed response is required, the user shall be alerted and given sufficient time to indicate more time is required.**

In the portal when user is idle for more than 20 minutes the session gets timed out and the user is logged out from the portal. Before logging out of the portal, it shows the session extend warning for the user 5 minutes prior to logging out.
